

VOTE CLIMATE 2020

Vote Climate 2020 is a Get Out The Vote (GOTV) campaign and a global Internet broadcast of empowering facts and entertainment to promote voting for climate crisis leaders and solutions. It is a project-based coalition with a growing alliance of climate activist organizations, launching a new Internet broadcast channel to empower committed climate voters. We support, and are supported by, a broad alliance of groups building the Vote Climate movement. We actively include voices and content from multicultural and intergenerational groups and people. Our goal is to reach millions and get as many new climate voters as possible voting. We must elect leaders that legislate climate policy with the same scientific focus and urgency as pandemic policy.

Vote Climate 2020 Alliance Group Agreement

- The Alliance Group Agreement is designed to be clear on the role and responsibilities of the Vote Climate 2020 Channel (VoteClimate2020.org) and its Alliance Groups.
- The Vote Climate 2020 Channel will be responsible for the production work, costs and liabilities related to the Vote Climate Internet broadcast
- The Vote Climate 2020 Channel will promote voting and registering new voters by promoting Alliance Groups that have GOTV campaigns and field operations.
- Alliance Groups will be promoted throughout the Vote Climate 2020 broadcast and on its website. A list of the Alliance Group's logo and link will be posted on our website. We will also post Speak Out video statements from their staff and leaders encouraging people to Vote and Vote Climate.
- A current list of all Alliance Groups will be included in a special website page. Alliance Groups will be invited to submit quotes for inclusion in our Vote Climate 2020 streaming broadcast.
- Alliance Groups are not required to make any financial contribution to the Vote Climate 2020 broadcast production costs, but can participate if they wish in the sponsorship support package.
- Each Alliance Group will promote the Vote Climate 2020 broadcast in a way that they decide will best fit their resources available for outreach and alliance support work. Each group will designate a main point person for alliance communications.
- An Alliance Group and the Vote Climate broadcast can end their Alliance Group agreement for any reason with 24-hour notice given by either party by email.
